INSTALLATION:

Connect the USB interface to your PC/laptop using a *USBA to Mini B* cable. The software drivers are usually installed automatically by the operating system and the interface appears in the Device Manager as a virtual COM port.

- 2) Connect the USB interface to your PC, run MAV Manager and select the correct COM Port.
- 3) Connect the device according to the picture below.
- 4) Select the *.BIN file and press the Update button.
